Scholastic Book Fair

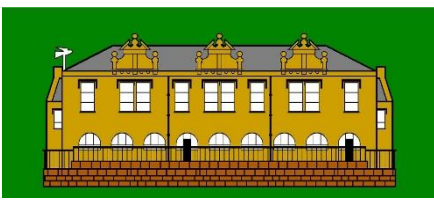
