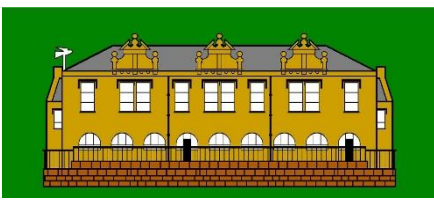
Jeans for Genes Day
