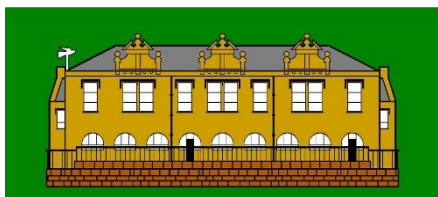
Another successful trip to Mount Cook!
