After School Clubs – Summer Term 2

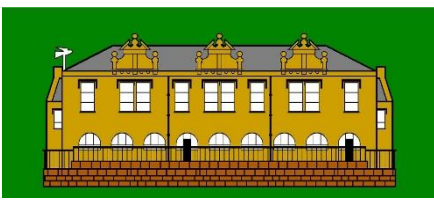
Clubs will commence **w/c 10th June** and will run for 5 weeks.
