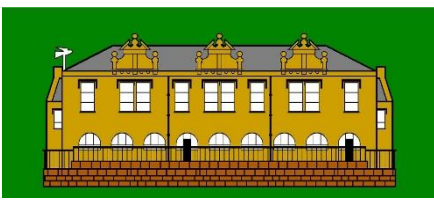
Lost Property
