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Holiday absence – reminder

You will already be aware we no longer give permission for holidays during term time, this was in accordance with DCSF guidelines which made it clear that term time holidays may only be treated as authorised in highly exceptional circumstances and be considered on an individual basis.

We have recently received updated guidance from the Local Authority regarding holiday absence during term time. The new guidance states that a Penalty Notice can be issued if any of the 3 conditions apply:

- A pupil has accrued at least five consecutive days of unauthorised leave of absence (holiday in term time)
- A pupil has accrued at least 5 days or 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in any 6 week period (longer periods can be considered)
- A pupil has accrued a level of absence that the governing body deem to be evidence of a failure to attend regularly.

The school should be notified in writing of any intended holiday absence for the attention of Mrs. Denham. Any unauthorised absences that meet the above criteria will be referred to the Local Authority.

Readathon! – reminder

Information was sent out via Book Bags at the end of last term. The Readathon starts on Monday 12th June and lasts for 2 weeks. Children set their own reading challenge and get sponsored for completing their challenge.
