Y6 parents – please can we make a special request that you check your child’s account to ensure you are up to date with all payments. Thank you.

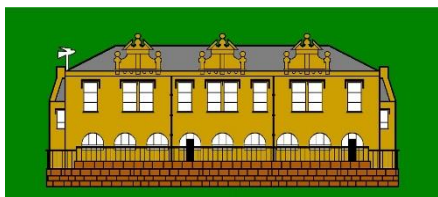
## Art week

- If your child is moving up from Primary School Year 6 to Secondary School Year 7 in September, they may be using public transport by themselves for the first time to get there. By ordering their Under 16 PhotoCard now you can make sure they don't get asked to pay a full adult fare as well as enjoying a whole summer of half-fare travel outings.
