At this point please can we remind everyone that face coverings should be worn when dropping off & collecting children to help keep us all safe!

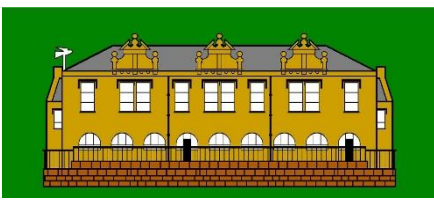
