We have recently been involved in some specialist training to deal with loss and bereavement. The rainbows provide a safe setting in school in which children and young people can talk through their feelings with their peers who are experiencing similar situations. They are helped to articulate their feelings by a trained facilitator. The training supports self-esteem, trust, confidence and resilience. It then promotes emotional development and positive, healthy relationships.
